Donors' confidentiality will be respected as details of individual donations will not be divulged to third parties except as required by law.

I note that I must pay an amount of Income Tax or Capital Gains Tax equal to the tax you reclaim on my donation. I must remember to notify you if I no longer pay tax to cover this declaration.

I understand that when the basic rate of tax is 20% the Friends of St. Martin's Eynsford can reclaim 25p for every pound donated under a valid Gift Aid Declaration.

If I am a higher rate tax payer I can claim higher rate tax relief for my donation against either Income Tax or Capital Gains Tax.
